

## Welcome to 4<sup>th</sup> Grade

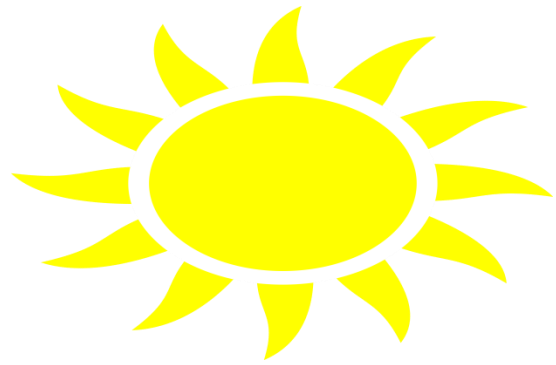

### **Science News:**

**3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> Grades will continue their investigations into living things – cells, plants, and animals but on different levels. In STEM 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade is finishing their work with magnets, 4<sup>th</sup> grade is testing their Lego catapults, and both will be moving on to 3-D “Modeling”. 5<sup>th</sup> grade has also been challenged to design and build a working catapult,**

**from scratch, that uses most simple machines as well as one that uses the fewest simple machines.**

## **Social Studies News:**

**3<sup>rd</sup> Grade – students continue to learn about “communities” - their celebrations, their environments, where they started, and how technology changes them.**

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade – students will learn about life in Colonial Maryland, the Revolutionary War, as well as the state government and economy of Maryland today.**

**5<sup>th</sup> Grade – students will learn about European explorers, their accomplishments, and how exploration led to the early settlements of North America. We will also learn about life in the 13 colonies.**

## **SCIENCE NEWS:**

**3<sup>rd</sup> grade – students will be learning about changes in weather, living things – how they grow and change, plus force and motion while working with simple machines in STEM.**

**4<sup>th</sup> grade – students will learn about weather and climate, living things – plants, plus force and motion by designing and building catapults in STEM.**

**5<sup>th</sup> grade – students will learn about weather patterns and the characteristics of living things.**



## **SOCIAL STUDIES:**

**3<sup>rd</sup> grade – students will be learning about communities here in the United States as well as in other countries.**

**4<sup>th</sup> grade – students will be learning about “Natural Maryland”, its physical features and regions. They will also learn about Maryland’s “First People” and become familiar with all the Maryland state symbols.**

**5<sup>th</sup> grade – Initially, students will be working on an “Overview” which highlights the American people, government, land, and resources. They will then study some past cultures to help them better understand the world today.**
