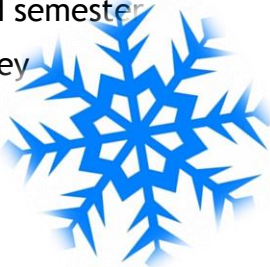


It is truly unbelievable that we are now almost half way through the school year, and we have ushered in yet another calendar year.

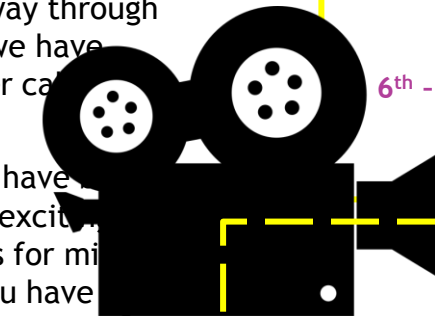

First Quarter - Curriculum

Social Studies -

During the first quarter students in sixth grade will be learning about the early Americas; spanning from North through central and finally finishing in South America. Seventh graders will begin their geographical exploration in the Fertile Crescent, then traveling west to Southwest Asia and Northern Africa. Eighth graders will be participating in two simulations: Colonization and Revolution.

Religion:

During the first quarter students in sixth grade will be demonstrating their understanding of the great gifts given to us by God. Seventh graders will explore the written word and how it is used to guide our understanding of the faith. Eighth graders will gain a deeper understanding of the faith and their part in a larger faith based world.
