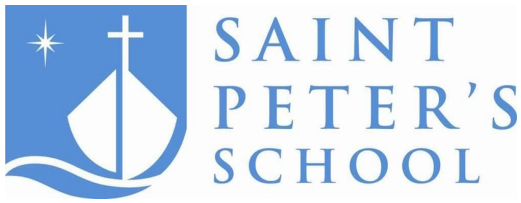


## Re-Opening Plan Fall 2020

Practicing Prevention	Saint Peter's Implementation
Daily	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Signage in classrooms, hallways and entrances communicating how to stop spread of COVID-19</li> <li>○ Disinfect student areas multiple times throughout the day.</li> <li>○ Requirement for students and all staff to wear face masks.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Masks will be required in common areas (hallways, bathrooms and arrival and dismissal) for all students in Pre-K-8<sup>th</sup> grade and all staff</li> <li>● Masks will be required for all students and adults in all the classrooms to the extent possible in classrooms.</li> <li>● Pre-k, K and 1<sup>st</sup> grade students will also have the option to wear a face shield and their desks will be protected with plexiglass desk shields.</li> <li>● Masks may be removed with physical distancing, when outdoors, when eating and when directed.</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ Deep cleaning of the school prior to reopening.</li> <li>○ Drinking fountains will be closed for drinking but the new touchless water bottle fillers attached to the drinking fountains can be used to refill student water bottles during the day.</li> <li>○ Student cell phones are encouraged to stay at home, if they must be brought to school, they will be kept in a phone holder in the student's homeroom.</li> </ul>

Entering School	Saint Peter's Implementation
<p>7:50-8:14</p> <p>There is no before school care</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ All staff members will be screened with a temperature and health questionnaire when entering the building.</li> <li>○ All students will have their temperature taken while in the car before being allowed to enter the school along with a quick health survey.</li> <li>○ Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to get out of the car.</li> <li>○ Students report directly to their classrooms. Grades 1,2 and 3 will enter through the classroom backdoors.</li> <li>○ Non-essential parental visits will not be allowed.</li> <li>○ All adults that enter the building will be screened about entering.</li> </ul>
Lunch and Recess	Saint Peter's Implementation
<p>11:00-11:20 Middle school</p> <p>11:25-11:45 3,4,5</p> <p>11:30-12:00 PK</p> <p>12:05-12:25 K, 1,2</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ All student's will eat lunch in their homeroom.</li> <li>○ All student's will put their mask in a personal brown paper bag when exiting for recess. Students do not wear their mask outside unless arriving to school in the morning or departing in the afternoon.</li> <li>○ All students will use hand sanitizer before they leave the classroom and upon returning to the classroom.</li> <li>○ Hot lunch is available for ordering from the Apple Spice Junction.</li> </ul>

## Re-Opening Plan Fall 2020

Transitioning	Saint Peter's Implementation
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Students will remain in their homeroom to maximum extent possible.</li> <li>○ The majority of special teachers will teach in the students' homeroom.</li> <li>○ Any transitioning the hall will be done following the CDC recommendation for social distancing and with a a mask.</li> <li>○ Students classes will not mix with other classes.</li> <li>○ Students will use the restroom as needed and be scheduled for block times with small groups. The bathrooms and high touch areas will be cleaned continuously throughout the day.</li> </ul>
Instruction	Saint Peter's Implementation
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ No more than 15 students in a class.</li> <li>○ Students will be sitting at every other desk.</li> <li>○ Students will not share supplies or materials.</li> <li>○ Teachers will be allowed to hold class outside weather permitting.</li> </ul>
Dismissal	Saint Peter's Implementation
<p>3:10-3:20</p> <p>There is no after school care available.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Students will be dismissed one class at a time starting with PK. Students should wear their masks out to their cars.</li> <li>○ Grades 1,2,3 will exit through their backdoors.</li> <li>○ Parents should wear a mask and stand in front of the car line to receive their child and return to their car awaiting directions from the parking lot director before exiting.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Vulnerable students will be given the option of distant learning. However, distant learning will vary greatly from grade to grade and should be discussed with the homeroom teacher during your "Great Your Seat appointment. "               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <b>Parents must choose an option of in-person or virtual learning for the entire first quarter. No changes will be allowed made.</b></li> </ul> </li> <li>○ No large gatherings will be allowed such as Mass, assemblies or sporting events.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ All families and staff will adhere to pandemic guidelines until further notice.</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ This plan is fluid and modifications to the reopening plan can be made at any time.               <p style="margin-left: 40px;">Signing off on the parent handbook acknowledges the policies and procedures in the reopening plan.</p> </li> </ul>
